ITEM 5. OTHER EVENTS AND REQUIRED FD DISCLOSURE.

On January 12, 2004, Gas Research Institute ("GRI") brought suit in federal district court in Illinois against MKS Instruments, Inc. ("MKS"), On-Line Technologies, Inc., which was acquired by MKS in April 2001, and another defendant for breach of contract, misappropriation of trade secrets and related claims relating to certain infra-red gas analysis technology allegedly developed under a January 1995 Contract for Research and incorporated into certain of MKS' products. GRI has made claims for unspecified damages, attorney's fees and injunctive relief. MKS is currently evaluating the merits of the claims. MKS cannot be certain of the outcome of this litigation, but plans to oppose the claims against MKS vigorously.
